 - 100 rooms meet brings in roughly 4000 athletes
 - may have to look at a couple different options. Deciding if first come first serve or split by program
- February 14-16, 2025 Motorcycle Classic: Milwaukee, WI
 - Level 6-10 compete
 - Hotel block will be arranged once we know how many athletes will be attending the competition. You can choose to stay at the hotel or stay someplace else. Travel to Milwaukee is on your own.
- February 28 March 2, 2025 Kupets Pink Meet: Savannah, GA
 - Level 6-10 and Xcel Gold-Sapphire compete
 - It is recommended that families book airfare for Thursday Feb. 27th to Monday March 3rd.

 - Travel to Savannah and lodging is on your own (make reservations where it works best for you).
 - Options: Hotels, VRBO/Airbnb (If a few families join together, a house can be cheaper than a hotel.)
 - Tybee Island is about a 20 minute drive to the convention center and it's a barrier island.
 - You can also look for a place near the convention center too.
- Travel Budget:
 - Once we know the Chicago competition schedule, Ryan will work on the all gym Coaches Travel Budget. The costs for staff travel will be charged to your accounts in February. You will also have the option to split the Travel Fees over 3 months. We <u>aim</u> for travel costs to be the following each year:
 - 1 Travel Meet: \$150 (Levels 3, 4, and Xcel Silver)
 - 2 Travel Meets: \$250
 - 3 Travel Meets: \$350 (Level 6-10 and Xcel Gold-Sapphire)
 - **Ryan Updated:** This information does not have boys info broken out Ryan has to check with Dale. The cost gets spread across ALL teams. Just split based on the number of meets.
