

North Shore Gymnasts Make Their Mark at the 2025 Glitz & Glam Invitational

Bloomington, MN – September 27–28, 2025 — North Shore Gymnastics Association competed across Levels 3, 4, and 5 at the *Glitz & Glam Invitational*, hosted by Rebels Gymnastics in Bloomington. The club combined poised routines with clean execution, highlighted by a first-place team finish for Level 3 and a slate of individual titles and podiums throughout the weekend.

North Shore's Level 3 team had an exceptional showing, taking first place in the team competition. In the Child A Division, Alison Moselle (7, Buffalo) earned first place All-Around, with victories on Beam and Floor, and second-place finishes on Vault and Bars. The Child B Division featured multiple highlights, including Hadley Hannay (8, Maple Plain), who claimed first place on both Floor and Beam, along with second on Bars and third on Vault. Teammates Nirvi Gandhi (8, Plymouth) and Olivia Ries (8, Orono) added podium finishes of their own, with Gandhi taking second on both Beam and Floor and Ries earning third on Beam. Rowan Smith (8, Minnetonka) secured third place on Bars, while Taylor Merz (8, Orono) impressed with a first-place finish on Bars and second on Vault. In the Junior Division, Brooklyn McCoy (8, Independence) earned second on Beam, third on Floor, and second All-around, while Ella Olson (8, Maple Plain) stood out with first-place finishes on Bars, Floor, and All-Around, in addition to a second on Vault. Bella Birthler (8, Mound) contributed a third place on Bars. In the Senior Division, Maya Kucera (9, Long Lake) captured first place All-Around, with wins on Beam and Bars and a third place on Floor, while Kora Bennett (11, New Hope) added first on Bars, third on Beam, and second All-Around.

The Level 4 team earned notable performances across their divisions. In the Child B Division, Joey Wood (8, Independence) took first on Vault, while also adding second-place finishes on Bars, Floor, and All-Around. Henrietta Berg (10, Delano) earned third place on Bars, and Sloane Svobodny (9, Mound) picked up a second-place finish on Beam. In the Junior Division, Gemma Johnski (11, Minnetrista) captured first-place on Floor, and Lydia Emery (10, Brooklyn Park) took third All-Around with first place on Bars.

In Level 5, Chachi Denniston (8, Maple Plain) delivered a standout performance in the Child Division, finishing second All-Around and first on Beam.

The *Glitz & Glam Invitational* was another successful meet for North Shore Gymnastics Association, as athletes across Levels 3, 4, and 5 showcased their talent, perseverance, and teamwork. With a first-place team podium finish and numerous individual champions, North Shore continues to prove its strength early in the competitive season.
