

# North Shore Gymnasts Shine at the 2025 Pink the Rink Invitational

**Grand Rapids, MN – September 12, 2025** — North Shore Gymnastics Association athletes had a standout weekend at the *Pink the Rink Invitational* in Grand Rapids, Minnesota. Competing across multiple levels, North Shore gymnasts collected team honors and numerous individual awards, highlighting the strength and depth of the program.

North Shore's Level 3 team captured the first-place team award, led by a series of outstanding individual performances across age divisions. In the Junior A Division, Alison Moselle (7, Buffalo) earned third place all-around, taking first place on Uneven Bars, second on Vault, and third on Floor. Teammate Rowan Smith (8, Minnetonka) secured fourth place All-Around while tying Moselle for second place on Vault. The Junior B Division saw a North Shore sweep of the podium, with Brooklyn McCoy (8, Independence) claiming first place All-Around along with first on Floor and third on Uneven Bars. Right behind her, Taylor Merz (8, Orono) earned second place All-Around while winning first on Vault and Uneven Bars and second on Floor. Hadley Hannay (8, Maple Plain) rounded out the podium with third All-Around, highlighted by a first-place finish on Balance Beam. In the Senior A Division, Maya Kucera (8, Long Lake) dominated with a first-place All-Around, claiming first place on Uneven Bars and Beam, second on Floor, and third on Vault, while teammate Ella Olson (8, Maple Plain) added to the medal count with a first-place finish on Floor. In the Senior B Division, Kora Bennett (11, New Hope) led the way with first place All-Around, finishing first on Vault and Uneven Bars and second on Beam.

The Level 4 squad also delivered a strong showing, finishing second overall in the team standings. In the Junior A Division, Joey Wood (8, Independence) captured first place All-Around with first place finishes on both Floor and Balance Beam, while Aubriella Bursch (8, Montrose) added a second place finish on Floor. In the Junior B Division, Henrietta Berg (10, Delano) earned third place All-Around and stood out with first place on Beam and second on Vault. The Senior A Division featured strong performances from Gemma Johnski (11, Minnetrista), who placed third All-Around and earned third place on both Beam and Floor, and Patty Peterson (10, Mound), who added a second-place finish on Beam. In the Senior B Division, Briana Figueiredo (12, Medina) secured third All-Around and claimed first place on Beam.

North Shore's Level 5 team also claimed second place in the overall team award. In the Junior A Division, Chachi Denniston (8, Maple Plain) delivered an outstanding performance, taking first place All-Around with first-place finishes on both Floor and Vault, second on Beam, and third on Uneven Bars. In the Junior C Division, Louise Parks (12, Long Lake) earned first place All-Around with first place on Beam and second on Vault, while Alexis Pohl (14, Corcoran) also contributed to the team's success with a first-place finish on Vault.

The *Pink the Rink Invitational* proved to be a successful meet for North Shore Gymnastics Association, with gymnasts at all levels showcasing skill, determination, and teamwork. With three teams placing in the top two and numerous individual champions, North Shore is well-positioned for continued success as the season progresses. Look for North Shore's Level 3-5 as they compete in Bloomington, MN on September 27th-28th at the Glitz & Glam Meet.
