

# North Shore Gymnasts are Golden at the Go For Gold Meet

**Little Canada, MN – October 4–5, 2025** — North Shore Gymnastics Association delivered a weekend full of strong performances at the Go For Gold Meet. With multiple team podium finishes and individual titles across all levels, the club once again demonstrated its depth and talent.

The meet started off on Saturday with strong Level 5 performances. In the Junior Division, Chachi Denniston (8, Maple Plain) swept the field with first-place finishes on Vault, Beam, Floor, and the All-Around, along with a strong second on Bars. In the Senior Division, Alexis Pohl (14, Corcoran) secured first place on Vault, while Beatrice Parks (12, Long Lake) added a third-place finish on Floor. The team took home Second Place.

Next up was a first-place finish by the Level 4 team. The Junior Division was led by Joey Wood (8, Independence), who took first on Vault, Bars, Floor, and the All-Around. Teammate Sloane Svobodny (8, Mound) placed second All-Around, while Aubriella Bursch (8, Montrose) earned third on Vault. In the Middle Division, Henrietta Berg (10, Delano) excelled with first on Vault, first All-Around, and second-place finishes on Bars and Beam. Her teammate, Vailynn Jahnke (9, Mound), took home second-place on Vault and first-place on Floor. Gracelyn LePage (9, Buffalo) added a first on Bars. The Senior Division saw Gemma Johnski (11, Minnetrista) claim first on Floor, third on Bars, and second All-Around, while Briana Figueiredo (12, Medina) contributed with second-place scores on Vault and Bars.

Another first-place team finish came from the Level 3 team at North Shore. The Junior A Division was headlined by Rowan Smith (8, Minnetonka), who dominated with first place on Vault, Beam, and the All-Around, along with second place on Bars and Floor. Teammate Spencer Kelley (7, Orono) claimed first on Bars, second All-Around, and additional third-place spots on Vault and Floor. Alison Moselle (7, Buffalo) took second on Vault, third on Bars, and first on Floor.

In the Junior B Division, Hadley Hannay (8, Maple Plain) impressed with first in the All-Around, Beam, and Floor, plus second on Vault and Bars. Taylor Merz (8, Orono) added first-place titles on Vault and Bars, plus a second All-Around. Jolene Eddy (8, Mound) posted podium finishes with second on Floor and third on Bars.

In the Senior A Division, Ella Olson (8, Maple Plain) earned top honors with first on Bars, Floor, and the All-Around, along with a second on Vault. Brooklyn McCoy (8, Independence) followed closely with second All-Around and second on Floor. Odyssey Jahnke (8, Mound) also contributed with a second-place finish on Bars.

The Senior B rounded out the Level 3's excellent showing with Maya Kucera (9, Long Lake) having an excellent meet with her first-place finishes on Bars, Beam, Floor, and All-Around. Kora Bennett (11, New Hope) claimed first on Vault and second-place on Bars, Floor, and All-Around.

The Xcel Silver team also competed at Go For Gold and found success across several events. In the Junior Division, Brielle Gullikson (8, Mound) delivered with first on Beam and third on Floor, helping secure the team's third-place finish overall.

With first-place team finishes at Levels 3 and 4, a strong second-place showing at Level 5, and third place in Xcel Silver, North Shore Gymnastics continues to prove its strength and consistency. The Go For Gold Meet highlighted the athletes' talent, perseverance, and teamwork, setting the tone for a successful season ahead.
